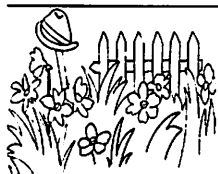
RULE AMENDMENT REGARDING RECREATIONAL VEHICLES EFFECTIVE AUG. 20, 2017.

As advised, any previously approved vehicle may remain if they are in good, operable condition with no visible signs of deterioration or otherwise and registered with the park office no later than Aug. 20, 2017. No new recreational vehicles will be approved, including replacement of existing vehicles. Registered and approved vehicles which are not maintained and require repairs which are beyond normal wear and tear must be removed from the lot at the expense of the resident and no approval for a replacement will be granted.

If you have not registered your recreational vehicle with the park office as of Aug. 20, 2017 please do so immediately. We will be inspecting the park to determine compliance, and all residents who fail to notify the park office of their vehicle will be asked to remove same.

Honey Mustard Grilled Chicken

1/3 C Dijon mustard	1/4 C. honey
2 TBS mayonnaise	1 TEAS. Steak sauce
4- boneless, skinless chicken breast halves	

Preheat grill to med. Heat. In a shallow bowl, mix the mustard, honey, mayonnaise and steak sauce. Set aside a small amount of the honey mustard sauce for basting and dip the chicken into the remaining sauce to coat. Lightly oil the grill grate. Grill chicken over indirect heat for 18 – 20 min., turning occasionally, or until juices run clear. Baste occasionally with the reserved sauce during the last 10 min. of cooking time. Watch carefully to prevent burning!
